Coupled with the Readers Workshop students are receiving multisensory instruction in both reading and spelling. A combination of Orton and PAF is being implemented based upon student's individual needs. Students began instruction in the Harcourt New Jersey HSP Math Series which involves a variety of learning modalities. This program definitely helps foster differentiation to meet the needs of all learners. Overall, the school year began with much enthusiasm on part of Mrs. Boniello's students and they look forward to this year's learning journey.
